### BMF KENYA SEPTEMBER 2024 REPORT

#### INTRODUCTION

##### KARAI WARD SPORTS OUTREACH

This month we commenced special outreaches involving volleyball, among the garbage collectors, the jobless, young and old men, in Karai Ward.

We have identified three playing grounds on Government land in Riu Nderi, Rurii and Gikambura Town.

We have already bought nets and footballs for two centres, trained facilitators within the two areas, and commenced weekly training practice.

Outreaches begin in the month of October as indicated in the table below.

These games were identified because they are in high demand and affordable to sponsor. We have a budget to buy nets, balls, dart-boards and draught -boards.

## **Report on BMF- UGANDA work for September 2024.**

### **REPORT on BMF- UGANDA WORK for SEPTEMBER 2024.**

On 28th September, Musisi Jude and I went to Butiti Prison. We arrived there at 2pm local time when the inmates were away for labour work. We waited until they came back at 4pm. The O.C assembled 316 men outside in the fenced compound. Jude gave a brief explanation about BMF followed by his short testimony, and then I gave my full story. 289 men received salvation. 12 of whom were Muslims. Jude opened the Bible and shared some Scriptures with the new born-again men so that they would have more truth about the new family of believers they have entered.

We donated five boxes of washing soap and four Bibles to that prison at the end.

On 29th September, Jude Musisi and I went to Kamwenge Prison. We arrived there at 8am when the inmates were still in the morning assembly. The O.C summarised what he was telling them and invited Jude to speak, He gave a brief explanation about BMF followed by his short testimony, and then I gave my full story. 219 men received salvation out of the 254 men who were in the assembly, 6 of whom were Muslims. Something which annoyed one of the Muslim wardens who was among those guarding the assembly, and he walked away from the place where he was assigned to stand. He shouted "Allah Akhbar" while abandoning his position, so that he couldn't guard his brothers being confused by Christians to denounce Islam. We donated five boxes of washing soap and four Bibles to that prison at the end.



On 30th September, Jude Musisi and I went to Ryantonde Prison. We arrived there at 9am when the inmates were inside their cells. The O.C assembled all the 273 men enrolled in that unit outside in the compound under the tree. Jude gave a brief explanation about BMF followed by his short testimony, and then I gave my full story. 248 men received salvation, 7 of whom were Muslims. We prayed together with the new believers and I am sure God will answer us. We donated five boxes of washing soap and four Bibles to that prison.
