Report on BMF- UGANDA work for December 2024.

On 8th December, Kasamba Jacob and Tumukunde Jimmy went to Nyabirongo Prison for the discipleship programme we started in that unit. They taught 58 inmates who are believers now, and covered from the book of Mathew 16:13-20 and Matthew 1:18-23.

On 22nd December, Kasamba Jacob and Tumukunde Jimmy went to Rusese-Bwera Prison and taught 68 believers who are on the discipleship programme. They covered from the book of Mathew 16:13.

On 28th December, Jude Musisi and I went to Mwera Prison. We arrived there at 11 am local time. The O.c welcomed us and took us to his office to sign in the visitor book, then he instructed the Officer on duty to assemble all the 183 men enrolled in that unit outside in the fenced compound. Jude gave a brief explanation about BMF followed by his testimony, and then I gave my full story. 169 men received salvation, and Jude opened the Bible afterward to minister to them, He delivered his New Year message to them and they were all happy to start the New Year with changed lives.

We donated five boxes of washing soap and four Bibles to that prison at the end.

On 29th December, Jude Musisi and I went to Kijumba Prison. We arrived there at 9:00am. The Officer on duty assembled all the men in the compound where they squatted in lines, but well spaced. Jude gave a brief explanation about BMF followed by his testimony, and then I gave my full story. 261 men received salvation out of the 309 men enrolled in that unit. Jude taught them a song praising Jesus first before he opened the Bible to teach them about faith in Jesus. We donated five boxes of washing soap and four Bibles to that prison at the end.

On 29th December, Kasamba Jacob and Tumukunde Jimmy went to Lake Katwe Prison and taught 107 inmates who are on the discipleship programme. They covered from the book of Luke 11:17, and they put much emphasis on the prodigal son.

On 30th December, Jude Musisi and I went to Muinaina Prison. We arrived there at 8:00am when the inmates were still in the morning assembly. We waited for 30 minutes and then they invited us to speak to them. Jude gave a brief explanation about BMF followed by his testimony, and then I gave my full story. 194 men received salvation out of the 236 men enrolled in that unit. Jude opened the Bible and read Scriptures about the healings of Jesus and he assured all men who received salvation that they will be healthy in the New Year that we are entering, and forever, through the healing power of Jesus. We prayed for all those who had health issues and they were made well.

We donated five boxes of washing soap and four Bibles to that prison at the end.
